The successful candidate(s) will ideally remain in Ghana for at least 3 years, living with and at the level of the local population, and will report regularly to the CHIPS Director in the UK.

The successful candidate(s) will be degree-educated, or have significant life/work experience in a relevant area. Experience living and working abroad, formal education in peace and development, relevant practical skills, and knowledge of participatory development approaches will all be advantageous.
