We are currently looking for a water resources specialist to join our local team in NE Uganda. The role will involve supporting and developing the capacity of the existing team in carrying out basic hydrogeological investigations and helping local communities develop sustainable water supplies. This is part of an integrated re-settlement project in the Teso-Karamoja border area of NE Uganda.

The successful candidate will hold an MSc or other degree in water engineering/hydrogeology or a similar discipline. They will need to have a strong Christian faith and to be willing to live a simple lifestyle in a remote rural area of Uganda. Experience living and working abroad, formal education in peace and development, practical skills, and knowledge of participatory development approaches will all be advantageous.

The position is for a minimum of 1 year starting by mid to late 2008. Training, tailored to the needs of the successful applicant, will be given prior to travel to Uganda. A local salary will be offered in addition to covering other costs.
