*Encouraged by the results of the CHIPS project in north east Uganda after 20 years, and aware of the desperate need for peace in our fractured world, CHIPS is about to begin a full-time training course for volunteer peacemakers lasting 18 months.*

*Is peacemaking, through Christ who is our Peace, your calling?*

**When does the training begin?** October 2012.

### **Do you have**

- A desire to do something worthwhile and effective?
- A willingness to engage with people at the deepest level?
- The capacity to live simply in another culture with local people?
- The potential to help transform grassroots situations through practical action (e.g. agriculture)?

And, are you inspired by the Christian Gospel?

### **What will the 18 months of training include?**

- Biblical principles and practice of Peacemaking
- Self-reliance in health and agriculture
- Two periods each of four months training with a CHIPS team overseas
- Learning about other cultures and how to integrate into the life of a village and much more !

**Where will the training take place?** Near Henley-on-Thames, Oxfordshire, England.

**How many places are available ?** We are looking for four people with a strong interest in peacemaking, who feel called to this ministry. As there are only four places available, the course will involve close and lasting fellowship.

### **What happens after you have completed the CHIPS training course?**

Volunteers will be offered the opportunity to serve with CHIPS overseas for a further three years.
